

### **3- Upgrading of computer labs in several Latin Patriarchate Schools**

#### **Diocese GA 211/20**

#### **Project Description**

The Latin patriarchate of Jerusalem is planning to upgrade and rehabilitate the computer labs of the LP schools for education and learning purposes. Nowadays, the computer labs are serving as the center for teaching different subjects across the curriculum. Computer and IT classes are conducted in computer labs by specialist teachers and are used by all the classes. Rehabilitating the lab spaces in the schools is considered one of the priorities of the LPJ in order to improve the learning environments in the classrooms, and to provide the students with compatible services.

The project development and engineering teams at the Latin Patriarchate undertook an intensive study and detailed surveys in the form of field visits to all the schools in Palestine and interviewed with the school principals and IT teachers, in order to evaluate the current conditions of the classrooms and observe the needs and requirements of each school. The team has made sure to match the needs with the national standards on the infrastructure and educational level.

The project will require **USD 50,000** distributed to several schools based on the need and priority.
