Project Summary:

This project provided the Mother of Mercy Clinic with up-to-date medical equipment and devices, to attain the national health standard required by all medical institutions and clinics by the Ministry of Health, as well as to keep developing the level of care the clinic provides its patients.

Established by CNEWA in 1982, The Mother of Mercy clinic is one of the most qualified Pre and postnatal clinics in the city. It's location in Al Zerqa is crucial, as the city is the 3rd largest in the country with the highest rate of unemployment, the highest birth rate, as well as the highest rate of people living under the poverty line. The initial goal of the clinic was to help displaced Palestinian refugees, it has developed to becoming a clinic that provides heavily subsidized medical care to refugees and foreign workers who have sought asylum in the city.

The overall objective of this project was met by replacing the old and worn out medical equipment and devices, as well as by purchasing new devices and necessities that the clinic is in need of. The priority was to purchase the Ultra-sound device, as the two devices at the practitioners' rooms have been used for over eight years, and one of them already needs regular repairs and maintenance.

Objective & Accomplishments:

The goal of this project was to aid the mission of the clinic, and help it continue providing health care and quality services in an atmosphere of empathy, compassion, generosity, and care to all its patients by equipping them with the necessary equipment. This has been accomplished by the generous grant provided by OESSH to be able to purchase the Ultra Sound Device and other required equipment.

The mother of Mercy clinic provides protective, diagnostic, therapeutic, and educational services, and especially promotes human and health development for females in need. The clinic also serves all its patients without distinction of race, religion, or nationality. It was able to continue its work and aid its patients better with the new equipment. The patients receive quality care for no to little cost, that can't be obtained at any other clinic or hospital.

The equipment has allowed faster processing times from initial testing to obtaining the final result, it has minimized technical error that was seen in the older devices, and has allowed the clinic to benefit more patients in need. It has also provided a better mental and physical experience for the patients knowing that they are being treated with the most up to date equipment.



Project Activities:

- The equipment was delivered to the clinic in September 2021
- Device and equipment were set up
- Quality control test and check was conducted
- The staff were professionally trained in handling and maintaining the new device as it is more advanced than the previous device at the clinic.
- The equipment have already been used since installation and are a great new asset to the clinic.

Beneficiaries:

There are 16,000 direct beneficiaries being serviced by the clinic annually. These beneficiaries are underprivileged locals and refugees from an extensive range countries. The newly installed equipment will be directly benefiting over 5000 patients annually, these beneficiaries include pregnant women, patients with abdominal issues, children, and infants.
